Jesus announced his Return

Jesus returns in a time when people will have lost faith.

- *“But when the Son of man comes, will he find any faith on earth?” (Luke 18,8)*

In these difficult times we must hold on.

- *“... hold on firmly to what you already have until I come” (Revelation 2,25)*

Jesus invites us to stay awake.

- *“So stay awake, because you do not know the day when your Master is coming... Therefore, you too must stand ready because the Son of man is coming at an hour you do not expect” (Matthew 24,42-44)*



The Apostles asked for signs

The Apostles asked Jesus about the signs of His Return.

- *"Tell us, when is this going to happen, and what sign will there be of your coming and of the end of the world?" (Matthew 24,3)*

Paul revealed to us that the wicked one (the Antichrist) must first appear.

- *"Please do not be too easily thrown into confusion or alarmed by any prophetic words... suggesting that the Day of the Lord has already arrived... It cannot happen until the Great Revolt has taken place, and there has appeared the wicked One, the lost One, the Enemy (of the Christ: the Antichrist)" (2 Thessalonians 2,1-7)*

The Antichrist will be annihilated by the Glorious Return of Jesus.

- *"The Lord will destroy him with the breath of his Mouth and will annihilate him with his glorious appearance at his Coming" (2 Thessalonians 2,8)*



How does the Return of Jesus take place?

Jesus returns through His Spirit to liberate people of good will.

- *“So Christ too, having offered himself only once to bear the sin of many, will manifest himself a second time, sin being no more – out of the body -, to those who are waiting for him, to bring them salvation.”
(Hebrews 9,28)*

Jesus returns on the clouds that is to say in the consciences.

- *“And they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of Heaven with power and great glory.”
(Matthew 24,30)*

Jesus returns like a “thief”. We must wait for his Return.

- *“Remember how you first heard the message. Hold on to that. Repent! If you do not wake up, I shall come to you like a thief, and you will have no idea at what hour I shall come upon you.”
(Revelation 3,3)*



"To those who are waiting for Him"

Jesus returns first to those thirsty of love, truth and justice. They are waiting for Him... Often without knowing it:

- *"...the hour is coming - indeed it is already here - when they will hear the voice of the Son of God, and all who hear it will live."* (John 5,25)

The Revelation gives back Life to those who identify the Beast and resist to it.

- *"Nothing unclean may come into it (the Heaven Jerusalem): no one who does what is loathsome or false, but only those who are listed in the Lamb's book of life..."* (Revelation 21,27)

Jesus manifests Himself to them to save them from the Antichrist.

- *"In a short time the world will no longer see me; but you will see me... and whoever loves me will be loved by my Father, and I shall love him and reveal myself to him."* (John 14,19-21)



"To bring them salvation"

This salvation consists in succeeding in the universal trial under the reign of the Antichrist.

- *“But the coming of the wicked One will be marked by Satan... aimed at those who are on the way to perdition because they would not accept the love of the truth... And therefore God sends on them a power that deceives people so that they believe what is false...” (2 Thessalonians 2,9-12)*

Salvation results from Christ’s support in this final trial.

- *“Because you have kept my commandment to persevere, I will keep you safe in the time_of trial which is coming for the whole world, to put the people of the world to the test.” (Revelation 3,10)*

To keep Jesus’ testimony: No to the Beast and its empire.

- *“And now I saw Heaven open, and a white horse appear; its Rider was called ‘Trustworthy’ and ‘True’; in uprightness He judges and makes war... Behind him, rode the armies of Heaven...” (Revelation 19,11-14)*



The reasons for the Return of Jesus

To unmask the Antichrist, the Beast of Revelation.

- *John warns us against the Antichrist who “denies that Jesus is the Christ” (1 John 2,22)*
- *In the Revelation John names it the “Beast” (Revelation 13 & 17)*
- *Jesus appeared on the 13th May 1970 to Pierre2 to reveal to him the identity of this Beast. This apparition inaugurates the Return of Jesus.*

To establish the Universal Restoration announced by Peter.

- *“Now you must repent and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, and so that the Lord may send the time of comfort. Then he will send you the Christ he has predestined, that is Jesus, whom Heaven must keep till the Universal Restoration comes...” (Acts 3,19-21)*



The signs of the Return of Jesus

Apparition of the Beast, the Antichrist, who *“was once alive, and is alive no longer (in the year 95); it is yet to come up from the Abyss”* (Revelation 17,8).

“It denies that Jesus is the Christ” (1 John 2,22).

Apparition of the false prophets

- *“Many false prophets will arise; they will deceive many”* (Matthew 24,11)
(all those who support the Beast and its empire)

Wars, nations against nations, famines, earthquakes

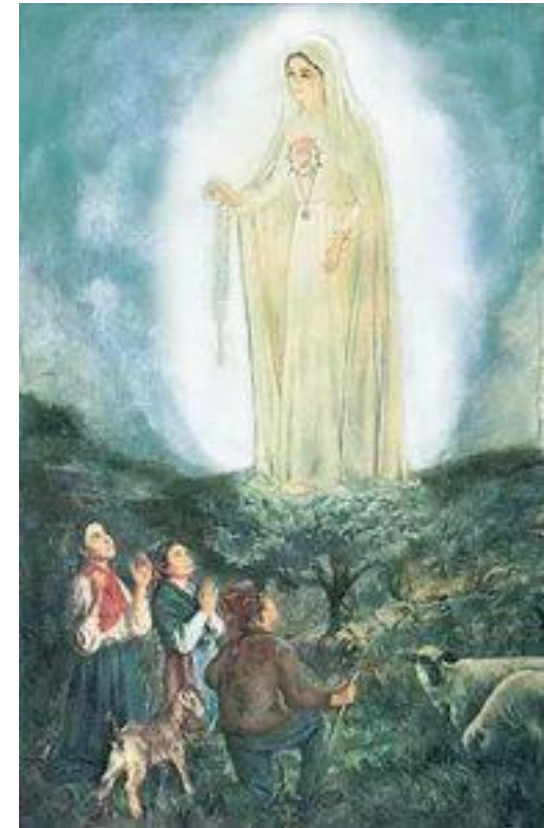
- *Matthew 24 / Mark 13 / Luke 21*

Betrayal

- *“And then many will fall away; people will betray one another and hate one another”*
(Matthew 24,10-13)

Signs from Heaven

- *Airplanes, satellites, missiles*
- *Apparitions of the Woman (Revelation 12) in La Salette, Fatima, Lourdes*



How does Jesus return?

Jesus returns through his powerful Spirit revealed by the “small open book” of Revelation

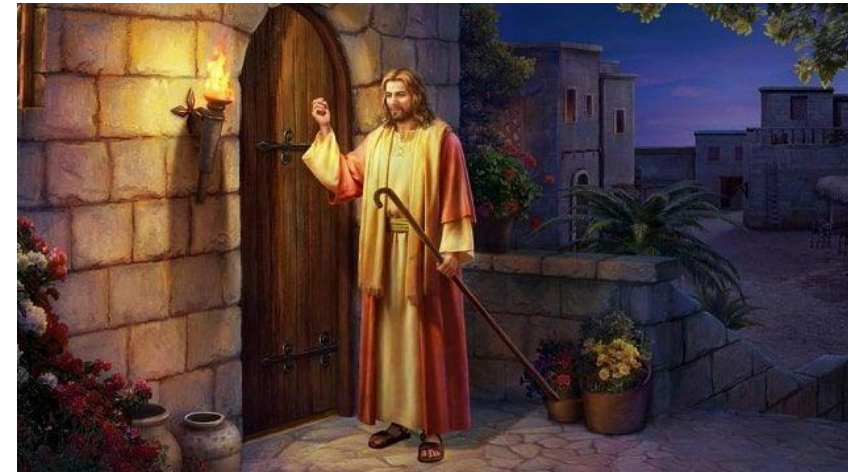
- *“Let the man of Spirit calculate the number of the Beast. it is the number of a human being, the number 666.” (Revelation 13,18) (Only people “of Spirit” will understand)*

Jesus returns through His Body, His Blood, His Spirit and His Divinity everyday in our homes

- *“Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will go into his house for supper, I will be near him and he will be near me.” (Revelation 3,20)*

Finally Jesus returns by strong events to punish his enemies and awaken his friends

- *“As it was in Noah's day, so will it be when the Son of Man comes people were eating, drinking... and they suspected nothing till the Flood came and swept them all away. This is what it will be like when the Son of Man comes” (Matthew 24, 37-39)*



In summary: Why does Jesus return?

Jesus returns to liberate the world from the Beast and its empire and to inaugurate new times:

- *“Then I saw the Beast, with all the kings of the earth and their armies, gathered together to fight the Rider and his army. But the Beast was taken prisoner, together with the false prophet... These two were hurled alive into the fiery lake of burning sulphur.” (Revelation 19,19-20)*
- *“Then I saw a new Heaven and a new Earth.” (Revelation 21,1)*
